

## Tenure Track Faculty Positions Department of Chemical Engineering Virginia Tech

The rank for the first position is open, and will be commensurate with experience and qualifications. The rank for the second position will be at the Assistant or Associate Professor level. Applicants should have a Ph.D. in Chemical Engineering or a related field, a record of excellence in research, and a commitment to teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels. Outstanding candidates in any experimental, computational or theoretical area of chemical engineering research are sought. Candidates with research interests in advanced materials, energy, and water sustainability would especially complement departmental priorities.
