Outstanding candidates from any field with an interest in working in a chemical and biomolecular engineering program are encouraged to apply, but areas of particular interest include (i) chemical biology, (ii) systems engineering, (iii) soft matter, (iv) electronics and photonics, and (v) nanomanufacturing.

Candidates should have a PhD in chemical engineering or a related field.
