All areas of chemical and biomolecular engineering are of interest, including but not limited to: chemical and synthetic biology, biotechnology and bioprocess engineering, catalysis and separations, energy and sustainability, process intensification and systems engineering, nanoscience and self-assembly, materials processing and nanomanufacturing, and soft matter physics and chemistry.

Candidates should have a doctorate in chemical engineering or a related discipline.
