

The Department of Chemical and Materials Engineering at the University of Kentucky invites applications for the position of Lecturer in Chemical Engineering. This is a non-tenure-track faculty position at the Engineering Extended Campus Program in Paducah, Kentucky, with duties oriented primarily towards undergraduate instruction in chemical engineering. The initial appointment will be for two years and is long-term renewable. The anticipated start date is Fall 2018.

Applicants must hold a Ph.D. degree in Chemical Engineering (or closely related fields). Prior industrial experience and/or professional licensure is valued. The successful candidate will be primarily responsible for teaching core courses in the chemical engineering curriculum. Applicants should have strong written and oral communication skills and a commitment to excellence in undergraduate education.

Review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled.
