

## **Tenure-Track Faculty Position (Assistant Professor)**

The Department of Chemical & Biological Engineering at The University of Alabama invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position within the area of catalysis. Candidates will be considered for appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor commensurate with experience and qualifications.
